## Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting Tuesday, November 1, 2022

The Town of Highland Lake held their regular council meeting, with Mayor Hanby calling the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m.

Invocation was given by Chase Moore.

The council led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Present: Councilmen Chase Moore, Carl Randall, Sid Nelson and Mayor Hanby.

Absent: Councilmen Greg Posey and Ramzi Malek

Minutes of the October 4, 2022 meeting were read by the clerk. Correction was made by Councilman Randall regarding item #5, regarding a reduction in hours of the clerk's salary. He stated that the verbiage was incorrect, as there was no reduction in pay. Attorney Alex Smith asked if the addendum mentioned in the minutes was voted on at the last meeting. After a long discussion, it was decided to call for a vote, as it was not clear if the addendum was included before or after the vote on the budget. A vote was proposed to accept the removal of June and July Saturday hours and to establish a maximum of 20 hours per week for the Town Clerk. Motion made by Councilman Randall, seconded by Councilman Nelson. Councilmen Randall, Nelson, Moore voted yes. Mayor Hanby voted no.

At this point, the Town Clerk stormed from the room saying "I quit".

The Mayor wanted to end the meeting at this point, but it was decided that a Financial Committee Chairman should be elected before leaving. Motion was made by Councilman Nelson to nominate Councilman Moore, and was seconded by Councilman Randall. All voted yes.

Mayor Hanby announced the office would be closed until further notice.

Councilman Randall made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Councilman Nelson. Motion passed and meeting adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
