Review and discussion of the February 6 regular meeting agenda items took place.

OTHER ITEMS DISCUSSED:

Street Signs - Mayor Vice advised the county will be replacing all street signs. Discussion took place on whether street signs were needed for undeveloped roads where there are no houses. Construction of new roads was also discussed. According to Commissioner Calvert, new construction of roads must meet the subdivision regulations. Attorney Alex Smith advised the town is not obligated to develop new roads.

Fred Harvey – Retaining Wall – regular meeting agenda to be amended to include retaining wall that was built as part of repairs when replacing their boathouse that was damaged by storms.

Goodner Farm Road Survey – Partial Road Vacation – need description of what is being vacated.


Ordinance Amendment to waive building permits in the event of a federal disaster – council will handle on a case-by-case basis instead of an ordinance amendment.
