**Review of March 5, 2019 Council Meeting Agenda Items** – review of items took place.

### **Other items discussed include:**

Ordinance HL-93-12 - unsightly yards.

Brasher Creek Berm clean-out – waiting on cost estimate from contractor. It was questioned should this work be done when the lake is lowered. Nelson/Malek to check with contractor.

Inspection at dam – Nelson to review/work on.

Discussed projects for when the lake is lowered September 7, 2019.

- Town boat slip posts will be removed when lake is lowered.

Work session opened to the public.

Gail Bailey questioned the location of the boat launch if moved.

Councilmember Hanby questioned if digital recordings of the meetings can be saved to office hard drive.

Carl Randall commented folks that damage the lake (ex: silt) should reimburse the town.

Bridge load limits – Mayor Vice stated our bridge load limits are 80,000 lbs. This is 20,000 lbs. more than the town ordinance states.
