ORDINANCE NO. HL02-2

**ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE 2000 INTERNATIONAL BUILDING
CODE**

Be it ordained by the Town Council of The Town Of Highland Lake as follows:

Section 1. That a certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the office of the Town Clerk of The Town Of Highland Lake, being marked and designated as the *International Building Code*, as published by the International Code Council, Inc., be and is hereby adopted as the *Building Code* for The Town Of Highland Lake, in the State of Alabama; for the control of building and structures as herein provided; and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said *Building Code* are hereby referred to, adopted, and made a part here of, as if fully set out in this ordinance, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in Section 2 of this ordinance.

Section 2. The following sections are hereby revised:

- Section 101.1, Insert: The Town of Highland Lake
- Section 1612.3, Insert: The Town of Highland Lake
- Section 1612.3, Insert: March 4, 2002
- Section 3409.2, Insert: March 4, 2002

Section 3. That Ordinance Number HL02-2, of the Town of Highland Lake, entitled Ordinance No. HL83-1 and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That nothing in this ordinance or in the *Building Code* hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding impending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 2 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

Section 5. That the Town Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance, and cause the same to be published as required by law; and this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval as required by law.
