AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE HL 05-01

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE RENTAL, USE AND MAINTENANCE OF BOAT SLIPS PROVIDED BY THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND LAKE

SECTION 1: ELIGIBILITY

- (1) Renter must be Town of Highland Lake property owner.
- (2) Initial rental of slips will be conducted on a lottery system. First number drawn will have their first choice of a boat slip. Second number drawn will have their choice of remaining boat slips and so on. After the initial rental, slips will be rented on an availability basis.
- (3) The lottery system will be used to determine the rental of boat slips not currently occupied. Only one boat slip per property owner will be allowed.
- (4) After a boat slip has been rented for two or more consecutive years, a property owner may be allowed to rent their slip without going through the lottery process.
- (5) If an existing rental slip becomes available, existing renters will have right of first refusal for that slip. This will be based on seniority.
- (6) A boat slip may not be sub-leased.

Passed and adopted this 5th day of October 2009. This amendment shall be effective five (5) days from and after the date of its adoption.
