ORDINANCE HL 05-04

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF TOWN OF HIGHLAND LAKE PROPERTY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF HIGHLAND LAKE, ALABAMA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

No boat, pontoon, seadoo, boat trailer or other property not belonging to the Town of Highland Lake shall be allowed to be parked along the shores or on any other property belonging to the town.

Property owners of Highland Lake may park their watercraft on their waterfront property, providing they have met their requirements of HL 96-01 requiring payment of a lake use permit of \$100.00 plus \$25.00 for each motorized watercraft, not to exceed 4 vessels per property owner.

Section 2:


Persons chosen under the rules of HL 05-01 concerning the rental of boat slips owned by the Town of Highland Lake will be the exception to Section 1 and must abide by all regulations of said ordinance.


Section 3:


Violation of this ordinance will result in a fine of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$100.00 per violation.


This ordinance will take effect upon the passage and publication as required by law.




