AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NUMBER HL 06-01

ORDINANCE FOR THE CONTROL, COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID
WASTE, AND THE PRESERVATION OF HEALTH,
SANITATION AND SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF HIGHLAND LAKE, ALABAMA,
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 13: It is unlawful for anyone to burn garbage or hazardous materials, such as roofing, plaster, tires, etc. within the Town of Highland Lake. "Rubbish", such as leaves, limbs of trees or other yard debris may be burned.

- (a) Any person electing to burn rubbish within the town limits shall do so in compliance with county, state, and federal restrictions in place at that time.
- (b) Only rubbish may be burned.
- (c) Rubbish may not be burned within ten feet of the waters edge, nor allowed to be swept into the water by rain, wind, snow, or wave action from boats.

Passed and adopted this 4th day of May 2009. This amendment shall be effective five (5) days from and after the date of its adoption.


