ORDINANCE NO. HL 97-04

AN ORDINACE TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMITS ON THE ROADS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF HIGHLAND LAKE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HIGHLAND LAKE, ALABAMA:

SECTION 1:

The speed limits herein after specified or established as hereinafter authorized shall be the maximum lawful speeds, for the coorporate limts of the city, and no person shall drive a vehicle at a speed in excess of the maximum limits.

SECTION 2: SPEED LIMITS

- A) West Lakeshore Drive 25 MPH.
- B) Lakeshore Loop 20 MPH.
- C) Echo Lane 20 MPH.
- D) Martin Drive 20 MPH.
- E) Highland Lake Dam Road, starting at the city limits shall be 20 MPH.
- F) Lakeshore Lane 20 MPH.
- G) Bear Creek Circle 20 MPH.
- H) Sunset Strip 10 MPH.
- I) Sunset Boulevard including West Sunset and East Sunset 20 MPH.
- J) Lakeshore Circle 20 MPH.
- K) Vista Drive 20 MPH.
- L) Hope Drive 20 MPH.
- M) Kennedy Drive 25 MPH.
- N) Woffard Drive 15 MPH.
- O) Lakeshore Drive 25 MPH except for 3/10 of a mile from County Highway 29, which is the S curve area, this shall be 10 MPH.

SECTION 3:

All streets within the cooporate limits of HIghland Lake shall be zoned NO PASSING.

SECTION 4:

Violators will be punished and/or fined as set forth by the State of Alabama.
