AN AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NUMBER HL 11-02

AN ORDINANCE TO CONTROL DOGS WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS OF HIGHLAND LAKE

SECTION 11: CONTROL OF DOGS ON TOWN PROPERTY

- 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to bring an animal onto Town property without proper restraint. Town property includes the town fishing pier, boat slips, boat launch ramp and pier, parking areas, municipal buildings, park and walking trail.
- 2. Owners desiring to bring their animals to these areas are required to keep them under control at all times. Animals MUST be maintained on a leash or appropriate restraint (defined as physical connection between owner and animal, not to exceed 12 feet in length).
- 3. Animal defecation on Town property MUST be collected by owner and disposed of in the appropriate disposal container provided by the Town.
- 4. Violation of this ordinance shall result in a fine plus appropriate court costs:
 - (a) First offense \$25.00 fine
 - (b) All subsequent offenses \$100.00 fine.
