ITEMS DISCUSSED:

Review and discussion of the September 4 regular meeting agenda items took place.

2018-2019 Budget:

- One cent sales tax money Will the county match these funds?
- Mayor Vice stated the town budget needs to represent actual needs and trends.

Town Boat Motor – estimate from Rodney's Marine changed to \$4000.00 trade-in for boat, motor and trailer due to its now out of season (changed from \$5000.00 trade in for V-hull boat). Mayor Vice mentioned the glitch in the 1033 program is still unresolved, and there is a possibility the town may not be able to participate.

The Mayor shared with the council information regarding the outstanding issues with the 1033 program. Discussion took place.

OTHER ITEMS DISCUSSED:

Town Boat Dock Estimates – The Mayor called Lakeside Boathouse, Parkers Boathouse and Flotation Systems for dock estimates. Depth is needed for a floating dock.

Road/Lake Safety Committee – Lake Committee to address the mission/goals of the committee.

Road Form requesting the culverts be connected that run under Lakeshore Drive and around the Goodner Farm area – engineered drawings are needed to connect culverts since it would be over 40'.

CAWACO Grant for Lights in the Park – The \$4300.00 grant money from CAWACO has been received. The Mayor thanked Chase Moore for his assistance with this grant. Communication regarding the grant will be posted on the Town website and Facebook. An email with pictures will also be sent to the community email distribution list and an article will be placed in the Blount Countian.
