## Work Session of the Town of Highland Lake, Alabama

The Highland Lake Town Council held a work session on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 at the Anchor. Mayor Vice called the work session to order at 6:05 p.m.

## ITEMS DISCUSSED:

Review and discussion of the September 5 agenda items took place.

**Road Form for Vista Drive Drainage Issue** – County Engineer has marked two locations where the water could flow if a culvert is installed. Council member Moore will contact the affected property owners to discuss.

**Safety barrier at dam**—Council member Nelson presented barrier floats that could be purchased to replace the existing curtain. The cost would be approximately \$1200.00. Discussion was also held regarding installing lights on seven stationary buoy/posts (approximately \$300.00) and purchasing new reflective signage that is needed for the buoys.

**Petition to Vacate Goodner Farm Road** – a request has been received for the town to vacate Goodner Farm Road. A petition is required from the abutting land owners to start the process. A public hearing is then required at least 30 days later and then the council would vote to either accept or reject the request.

**Paul Latham – New Boathouse** – Building Inspector Tim Moore stated he did the pre-site inspection and marked where the construction should start.

Change Stop Sign from Martin Drive entering Highland Dam Road to Highland Dam Road where Martin Dr and Highland Dam Rd intersect – Commissioner Calvert stated this is a town council decision. It was suggested that input be obtained from resident Don Martin who would be the main person impacted by this decision.

## Other items discussed:

**Police budget categories** – Chief Kon stated he would like to transfer \$3500.00 from Police Salaries to Police Related Expenses. The police salary category is going to underrun since we did not have a second police officer during most of the summer. A vest needs to be purchased for Officer Buchanan. Also maintenance is needed on both police vehicles.

73 Sunset Blvd Update – the clean-up recently done by the property owner is in compliance with the town ordinance and must be maintained.

**Dumpster Project – yes or no** – the price for renting a dumpster for the weekend is approximately \$600-\$700. Discussion took place on whether to do this project.

**Hosting a Triathlon** – it has been suggested the Town host a triathlon. The council was receptive to this idea as long as someone else organizes it and uses the town as the venue (ex: Blount Sav-a-Life Annual 5K Run).
